"And now, presenting 'Virginia's Finest,' The James Madison University Marching Royal Dukes!" This familiar announcement begins each exciting half-time at JMU home football games as the marching band takes the field with their spectacular musical renditions and fast paced drill maneuvers. The 325 piece Dukes have been recognized as one of America's finest marching bands. With humble beginnings in 1972, the first year of football at JMU, the Marching Royal Dukes have quickly moved to the fast track of collegiate bands in America.

The Marching Royal Dukes have received many awards and they have been selected to perform at many prestigious events. The MRD's have performed at NFL games in Pittsburgh, Baltimore and Washington. In 1983, they were the halftime show for the NFL Championship game between the Washington Redskins and the Dallas Cowboys. The band has been a featured performer for Walt Disney Productions and the Richmond Christmas Parade. In 1988 and 1991, the Marching Royal Dukes were the featured band at the Bands of America Grand National Championship.

In 1994, the John Phillip Sousa Foundation selected the Marching Royal Dukes as the recipient of the Sudler Trophy. This award is the Heisman Trophy of college marching bands. In 1997, the MRD's were featured in President Bill Clinton's Inaugural Parade and in 2001 they performed for the inauguration of President George W. Bush. Also in 1997, the Marching Royal Dukes took their first European tour. They performed at the palace in Monaco for the closing ceremonies of the 700th anniversary of the Grimaldi Family. The Dukes then gave exciting performances in Cannes, France and Genoa, Italy. As the Dukes paraded down streets filled with rich European tradition, thousands of fans followed them shouting "JMU." In December 2000, the Dukes once again performed in Europe for the New Year's Celebration in Athens, Greece with an estimated audience of more than 500,000. On Thanksgiving Day, 2001, millions on national and international television saw the MRD's as they performed in the 75th Annual Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade in New York City. On December 26, 2003, the Marching Royal Dukes will leave for Ireland & Heidelberg, Germany for their third European tour. They will return on January 4, 2004.

The Marching Royal Dukes have become well known for their recordings. The band's first recording was produced in 1978. In 1983, they began their tradition of producing a new recording each year. In 1988, the Dukes produced their first compact disk. The Marching Royal Dukes recordings are available at the JMU Bookstore. The outstanding sound of the Dukes has led them to do featured recordings for Warner Brothers Publications, Columbia Pictures Publications, and C. L. Barnhouse Publications
