

ABOUT IMU

James Madison University was established as the State Normal and Industrial School for Women at Harrisonburg by the Virginia General Assembly in 1908. Since then, it has grown into today's coeducational and comprehensive university with an enrollment approaching approximately 16,000 students and a faculty and staff of over 3,000. Expanding upon its 605 acres in the beautiful Shenandoah Valley, the JMU campus is home to over 100 buildings, including a new Athletic Performance Center (2005) and Biotechnology Building. Plans for a new Performing Arts facility are currently under way. James Madison University is recognized repeatedly by national publications as one of the finest institutions of its type in America.

PERFORMANCES and AWARDS

- 1972: First season of JMU Football and the Marching Royal Dukes
- 1978: First recording produced
- 1983: Performed in the halftime show for the Washington Redskins vs. Dallas Cowboys NFC Championship game
- 1983: Began yearly recordings
- 1988 and 1991: Featured at the Bands of America Grand National Championships
- 1994: Received the John Phillip Sousa Foundation's Sudler Trophy the Heisman Trophy of collegiate marching bands, recognizing the Dukes as one of America's finest marching band programs
- 1997: Featured in President Bill Clinton's inaugural parade
- 1997: First European tour, performed at the royal palace in Monaco for the closing ceremonies of the 700th anniversary of the Grimaldi family. Also gave exciting performances in Cannes, France and Genoa, Italy
- 1998: Recorded first CD
- 2000: Second European Tour; performed at the New Year's celebration in Athens, Greece, before an audience of over 500,000
- 2001: Featured in the inaugural parade of President George W. Bush
- 2001: Performed in the 75th Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade
- 2002: Performed at Virginia Governor Mark Warner's inaugural ceremonies
- 2003: Third European Tour; featured at the New Year's celebration in Dublin, Ireland; visited Heidelberg, Germany
- 2004: Performed at the NCAA Division I-AA National Championship game in Chattanooga, Tennessee
